

Two giant Caterpillar 775G delivered to Cyfield by CTC Automotive Ltd

In a ceremony held at the Shacolas Group headquarters, two giant dump trucks Caterpillar 775G were delivered from CTC Automotive Ltd to Cyfield construction company, for use at the company's quarry in Pareklisia.

These are the largest heavy-duty Caterpillar equipment ever imported in Cyprus, having a transport capacity of over 70 tons, valued at €1,600,000.

The United States Ambassador Ms Julie Fisher honoured us with her presence at the ceremony, while Cyfield was represented by one of its directors, Despina Chrysochou.
